However, the church worship area is open for private prayer on Sunday afternoons from 2pm to 3pm. Some activities are continuing in various ways in an amended form. Worship Services using Video-conferencing

Our 'gathered' Sunday worship is being done through video-conferencing (Zoom). Ideally, you will need a computer, tablet or smart phone that has video and microphone capability. However, you can listen in to the service via an ordinary phone.

The next service will be at 10.30am on Sunday 26th July and will be led by Pam Howie and Andrea Clark. The passage we will be focusing on is Matthew 13:31-33,44-52.

If you are unable to join in these services, you can carry on worshipping at home. We will continue to send out some resources for this. Some of these will link with what is being done by video-conferencing, so if you use them at 10.30am on a Sunday morning you may feel more connected with that service and with others worshipping at home at that time.
