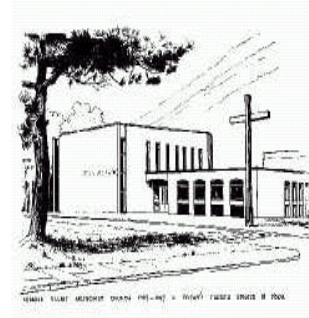

You are probably aware that a team of dedicated people help to count the  
collection after the morning service each Sunday. A couple of people are leaving
