**Christian children's books** are available to loan from Emma Coe.

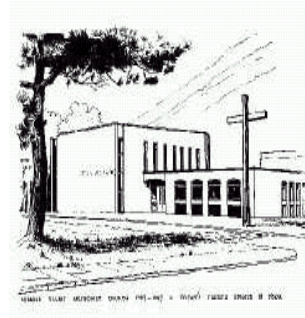
