

There is currently a desperate need for all women's clothes - tops, bottoms, jumpers, t-shirts, dresses etc and underwear in all sizes. Also any footwear (trainers, pumps, ballet pumps etc) although nothing with heels above 2 ½ inches. This is for women of any ages from 18 years old up to 70 years. Second hand bras and socks are ok but knickers would have to be new. If you are able to donate anything please bring it to Philip's office at Bramhall Methodist Church and he will take it to Styal.
