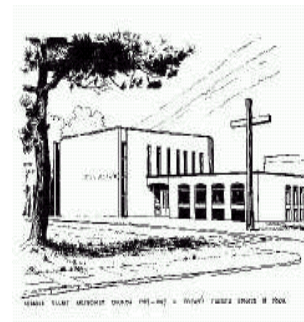

Can you help?

The Resources Team need volunteers for the following roles.

A person to set the heating each week over the winter period – this involves about 1 hour each week to come in and set the programming for heating for the following week. If you have a new digital programmer at home, and you can set it, then the church ones are very similar! Please speak to David Bailey (Resources Team Leader) or Richard Watson if you would like to have a go at this role.

A person to look after and respond to the emergency property phone – it has been described by one holder as ‘a lovely little quiet phone’! i.e. it doesn’t ring very often! The holders look after the phone on a rota basis for two weeks at a time, if someone is hiring a room and finds a problem they can ring the emergency phone and receive advice or help from the person on the other end. We have stand by contacts so, if the phone holder is not able to come down to church, if that is what is required, other people can be contacted for assistance. Please speak to David Bailey or Maggie Thompson if you would like to offer help or find out a bit more about the role.

People to come onto the Resources team that have an interest in the up keep and running of the building. This entails three evening meetings a year and, where possible, offering to assist when property roles require ‘hands-on’ action.
