On the 11th August, a team of 12 climbers (aged 14 to 18) will attempt to climb the height of Everest (8848 metres) in less than 12 hours at the Awesome Walls indoor climbing centre. We are doing this in memory of Harry Dubois, a good friend of 2 of the explorers, who tragically died at the age of 17 during the Easter holidays just weeks before taking his A levels. He suffered an Aortic Dissection which would have been found if a routine check had been made. His family and friends have been raising money to increase the preventative checks made for young people and also the research into finding the signs.
