



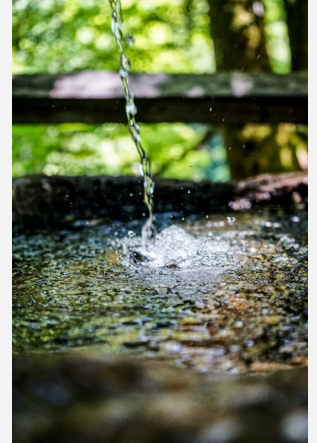

Ultimate Book Club

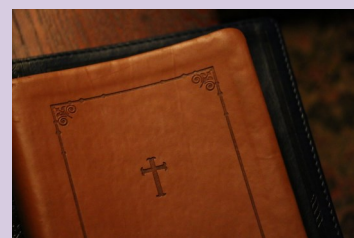
Colin Walter, will address us on the remaining minor prophets of Obadiah, Zephaniah, Haggai & Malachi on Sunday 7th November at 2pm.
