Church QR Code for Test and Trace

If you've downloaded the **NHS Covid-19 app** onto your smart phone or other device, you will probably know that **QR codes** are now available to scan at different locations eg coffee shops.

Churches have been asked to register for their own **QR code** and CHMC now has one, which can be found on **posters around the building** (the QR code looks like a chequer board square)

If you have the NHS app, you can **scan the QR code** on entry to the building and this will feed information into the government Test and Trace system.

However, this will **run in tandem** with (and isn't an alternative to) the **Test and Trace sign in system** that we currently have in place so it's important that **everyone continues to sign the Test and Trace form every time they enter the building (even if you've scanned the QR code)**
