Prayer after the Sunday Service

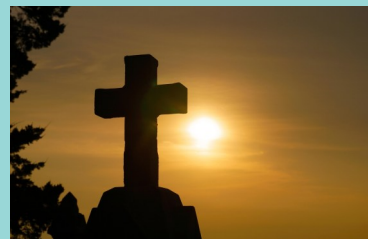

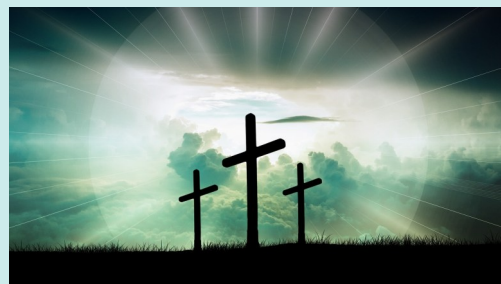
CHMC Prayer time - Sunday 13th September 11:45am

If you have bought items or knitted things for the shoeboxes please bring them to church as soon as possible so we know what else we need to purchase with your donations.

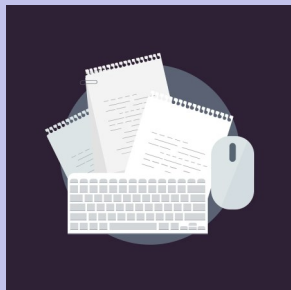
