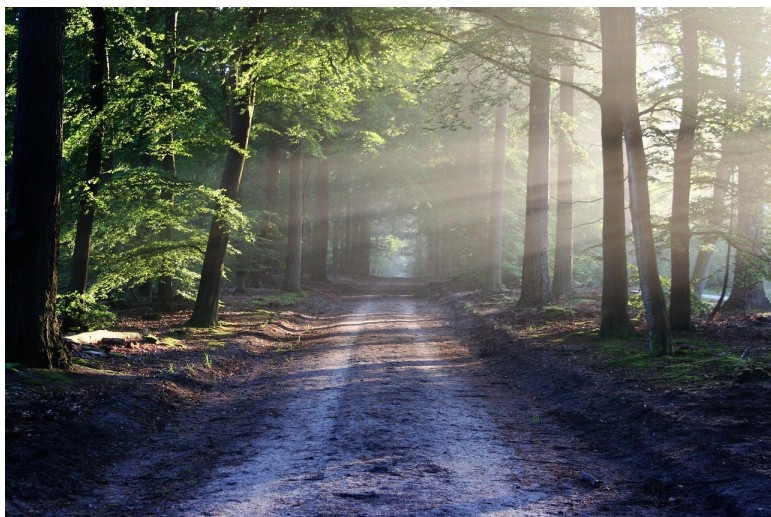

£10 per ticket, under 16s free. Tickets available from the church office, or from Hazel or Gill.

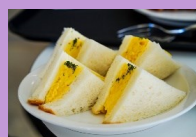
Praise Tea
