meeting on 10th February, passed the following with regard to the details of pastoral visitors.

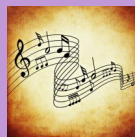
That, in the next edition of the church directory, a list of pastoral visitors be shown, and that, alongside the entry for each member, a code denoting the pastoral visitor for that member.
